

Aaron V. Dean, Sergeant, Co. E, 9 MS Infantry, CS

- 1838 February 16: Born to Hardy and Cynthia Pitts Dean in Marshall County, Mississippi.
- 1850 September 2: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Marshall County, MS showed twelve year old Aaron lived with his parents and five siblings. His fathers occupation was listed as a farmer.
- 1860 June 28: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in DeSoto County, MS showed twenty-one year old Aaron lived parents and siblings. He and his fathers occupation was listed as farmer.
- 1861 February 26: Enlisted into Co. E, 9 MS Infantry as a Sergeant.
- March-June: Company Muster Roll: Present
- July-August: Company Muster Roll: Present
- September-October: Company Muster Roll: Present
- November-December: Company Muster Roll: Discharged 16 Nov for disability and final statements given.
- 1864 November 30: Wounded at the Battle of Franklin, TN.
- December 15: Died of wounds sustained in the Battle of Franklin. Buried in Dean Cemetery in Nesbit, MS.
