

William R. Campbell, Private, Co. D, 8 AR Infantry, C.S.

- 1841 March 8: Campbell was born in North Carolina.
- 1861 July 16: Enlisted in 8 AR Volunteers, Co. F West Point Rifles.
- September 10: Service transferred in the C.S. Army. He was mustered into Co. D, 8AR Infantry.
- 1862 January & February: Company Muster Roll. Present.
- February to June: Company Muster Rolls. Absent. Remarks "Absent sick."
- June to December: Company Muster Rolls. Present. Remarks "Came in since mustered."
- 1863 January to December: Company Muster Rolls. Present.
- 1864 January & February: Company Muster Roll. Absent. Remarks "Absent with leave."
- February to September: Company Muster Roll. Present. Remarks "Pay due for the months of Nov & Dec 1863 by error on pay rolls of Jan & Feb 1864."
- November 30: Wounded at the Battle of Franklin.
- December 17: Captured in Franklin.
- December 27: Received at U.S.A. Hospital #1 in Nashville.

- 1865 March 19: Received at Louisville and forwarded to Camp Chase, OH.
- July 5: Reported at the refugee office in Washington D.C.. He was furnished transportation to Worchester, N.Y.

- 1870 August 2: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Alamance County, NC showed an unemployed William living with a William Holt family. William Holt was a wheelwright. Living in the next household is a young woman named Mary C. Noah.
- 1871 April 30: Married Mary Caroline Noah in Alamance County, NC.
- 1880 June 8: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Alamance County, NC showed Wm. R., a farmer, living with his wife and children.

- 1923 August 7: William Raleigh Campbell died. He was buried at Harmony Baptist Church Cemetery in Haywood County, TN.
