



Susanna "Susie" Carter Mayberry
1845-1909
Enslaved at the Carter House

1843-5 (abt) Susie was born in Tennessee.

1850 U.S. Federal Slave Schedule showed F.B. Carter owned fifteen slaves. Susie was most likely one of the female children listed as 7 or 8 years old.

1860-1862 (abt) Susie gave birth to sons Henderson "Hene" and Oscar in Franklin, Williamson County, TN. Their birth years are not clear or consistent.

1863 Susie was a witness on F.B. Carter's claim to the U.S. Government for items taken by the U.S. Army during the army's occupation of Franklin in 1863.

1864 November 30: Susie was about nineteen years old during the Battle of Franklin. She would have been in the cellar with her children. She was a witness to the U.S. soldier confiscations in November of 1864 as well.

1870 June 7: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Franklin, Williamson County, TN showed Susan Carter living as a domestic servant in the household of Elizabeth Mayberry. Living with Susan were her two sons Oscar and Charley.

1874 (abt) Susie gave birth to son John Carter.

1875 May 27: Susie married Austin Mayberry in Williamson County, TN.

1878 September: Susie gave birth to daughter Leonora Mayberry.

1880 June 18: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in District 3, Williamson County, TN showed Susan and Austin living with their infant daughter Leonora and her three sons: Henderson, Oscar and John.

1882 February: Susie gave birth to son Robert Mayberry.

1885 May 10: Susie gave birth to daughter Susie Mayberry.

1886 May: Susie gave birth to son Henry Mayberry.

1900 June 1: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Hillsboro, Williamson County,

TN showed Susie and Austin, a day laborer, living with their children: Robert and Henry. Living in the household directly next door was Susie and Austin's daughter Leonora Watson and her family.

1909 May 19: Susie Carter Mayberry died of stomach cancer.
