## William A. Davie, Captain, Co. I, 46th GA Infantry, CSA

- 1834 Davie was born in Georgia to Wilbon and Nancy Davie.
- August 14: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Talbot County, GA showed Davie lived with his parents on their farm, along with his six siblings: Marshall, Joseph, Hanson, Francis, Laura, and Robert. Also living with them was a 39 year old woman named Eliza Hearshall.
- March 4: Enlisted in the Confederate Army. Company Muster Roll denoted Talbotton, GA as Davie's point of origin. He was mustered into Co. I, 46th GA Infantry as a lieutenant.

March - April: Company Muster Roll. Denoted Davie as Present. Remarked that he was paid a bounty of \$50.

May - June: Company Muster Roll. Denoted Davie as Present. Remarked: "Promoted from Lt. to Captain on the 6th day of June 1862."

July - August: Company Muster Roll. Denoted Davie as Absent. Remarked: "Absent on sick leave from 18th August for thirty days."

- 1863 January December: Company Muster Roll. Denoted Davie as Present.
- 1864 January August: Company Muster Roll. Denoted Davie as Present.

August 20: Davie appeared on an Inspection Report that showed he was present at the Battle of Atlanta.

November 30: Davie was killed in action at the Battle of Franklin. He was buried at the McGavock Confederate Cemetery, Section 77, #13.
