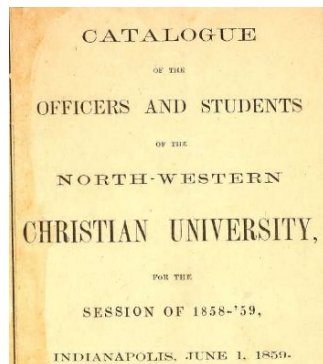




Addison M. Dunn, Captain, Co. E, 57 IN Infantry, US

- 1838 Born to Jeremiah and Hannah Boxley Dunn in Indiana.
- 1850 October 8: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Clinton County, IN showed thirteen year old Addison lived with his parents and five siblings. His father's occupation was listed as a farmer and the value of real estate owned was 1200 dollars.
- 1859 Addison was listed as a student in the English School at North-Western Christian University.

- 1860 August 14: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Hamilton County, IN showed twenty three year old Addison lived with his mother and his eight three year old grandfather, George Boxley, along with his six siblings. Addison's occupation was listed as a farmer. His father, Jeremiah, was listed on the 1860 Federal Census enumerated in Missouri as a day laborer. Jeremiah was not residing with the family at the time of the Census report.
- 1861 November 18: Mustered into Co. E, 57 Indiana Infantry, US.
- 1864 March 5: Accepted Veterans Furlough
- July 27: Slight Wound
- November 30: Killed in action at the Battle of Franklin, TN.
- 1867 September-July: Exhumed from the battlefield of Franklin and reburied in the city cemetery in Columbia, TN.
- November 20: Exhumed from Columbia and reburied in Stones River National Cemetery in Murfreesboro, TN.
