

## **Jacob Alderman, 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant Co. 3, 15<sup>th</sup> AK Infantry, C.S.**

- 1838(abt)     Jacob Alderman was born.
- 1861           July 23: Jacob Alderman enlisted in the C.S. Army in Pitmans Ferry, AK. He mustered into the 15<sup>th</sup> AK, Company E.
- July 23 – August 31: Company Muster Roll. Present.
- 1862           January – February: Company Muster Roll. Present
- February 28 – June 30: Company Muster Roll. Present, remarks “Promoted to 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant May 8, 1862.”
- July – August: Company Muster Roll. Present.
- September – December: Company Muster Roll. Absent, remarks “Sick in KY Oct. 1/63”
- November – December: Company Muster Roll. Present.
- 1863           January – February: Company Muster Roll. Present.
- March – April: Company Muster Roll. Absent, remarks “Suspended and in Chattanooga by order of General Hardee March 24/63.”
- May – June: Company Muster Roll. Present, remarks “Suspended.”
- July – December: Company Muster Roll. Absent, “On detached service under General Pillow, August 11 by order of General Bragg.”
- 1864           January – February: Company Muster Roll. Absent, “On detached service Carrollton, Alabama, August 11 by order of General Bragg.”
- July – August: Company Muster Roll. Present.
- Jacob S. Alderman 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt, Co. H, 15<sup>th</sup> Regt. AK Inf. Appeared on the roll of Prisoner of War at Military Prison, Louisville, KY: Date when Received: December 3, 1864. Where Captured: Franklin, Tennessee. Date when Captured: November 30, 1864. Date when Discharged: December 3, 1864. Where sent: Johnsons Island. Remarks: Nashville.
- 1865           June 16: Jacob S. Alderman was released on oath.
