

### James Elijah Koontz, Sergeant, Co. F, 3 TN Infantry, US

1840 Born to George and Sarah Ezell Koontz in Knox County, Tennessee.

1850 November 29: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Knox County, TN showed ten year old James lived with his grandparents Solomon and Mary Ezell.

1860 August 4: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Knox County, TN showed nineteen year old James lived with his mother and siblings. His mother's occupation was listed as domestic and his occupation was farmer.

September 23: Married Mary Majors in Knox County, TN.

1862 February 10: Enlisted into Co. F, 3 TN Infantry, U.S. in Flat Lick, KY.

August 31-December 31: Company Muster Roll-Present

1863 January to October: Company Muster Rolls. Present.

1864 January to August: Company Muster Rolls. Present.

November 30: Fought at the Battle of Franklin.

1865 February 23: Mustered out of the U.S. Army in Nashville, TN

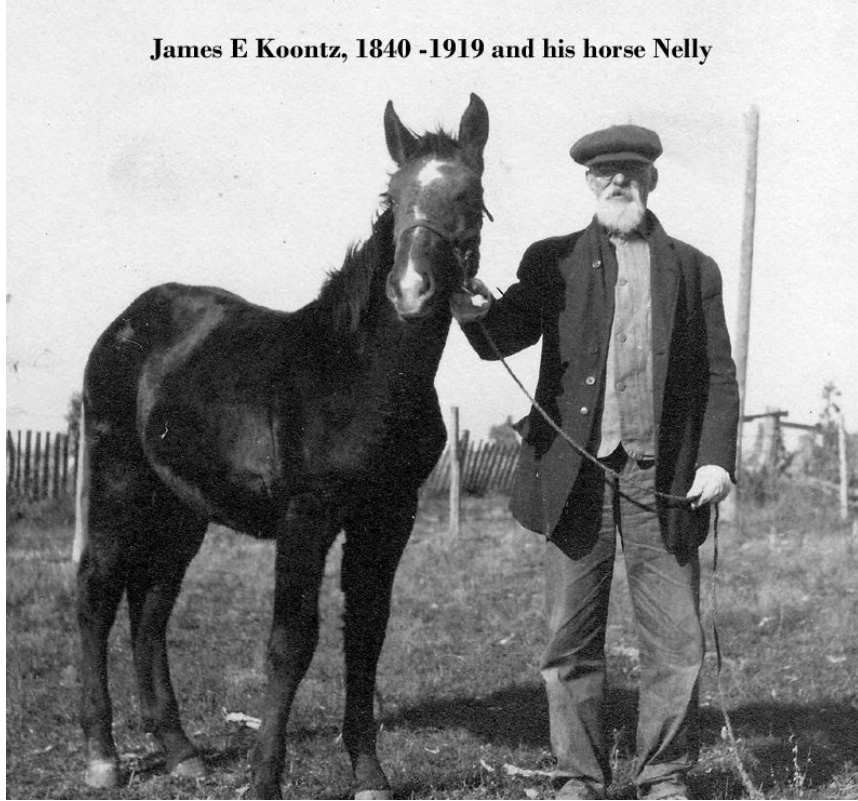
- 1870 June 30: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Union County, TN showed James, wife Mary, and their five children lived in Maynardville. James occupation was listed as a farm laborer.
- 1880 June 4: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Union County, TN showed James lived with his wife and children. He is listed as a farmer.
- 1890 The U.S. Federal Census Veteran's Schedule listed James lived in Union County. Disability incurred listed pain in the right side.
- 1900 June 16: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Union County, TN showed James lived with his wife and two of his sons, his daughter in law and grandchild.
- 1907 March 1: Koontz's wife Mary died.
- 1908 August 21: Married Hannah Hutchinson in Union County, TN.
- 1910 April 19: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Union County, TN showed James lived with his new wife Hannah and their child Myrtle. Occupation listed as own income.
- 1919 July 12: James Koontz died in Union County, TN and buried in Milan Cemetery.
