

Joseph Jefferson Dean, Lieutenant, Co. E, 9 MS Infantry, CS

1842 March 24: Born to Hardy and Cynthia Pitts Dean in DeSoto County, Mississippi.

1850 September 2: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Marshall County, MS showed eight year old Joseph lived with his parents and five siblings. His fathers occupation was listed as a farmer.

1860 June 28: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in DeSoto County, MS showed eighteen year old Joseph lived with his parents and siblings. He and his fathers occupation was listed as farmer.

1861 September 1: Enlisted into Co. E, 9 MS Infantry as a Private.

March-June: Company Muster Roll: Present

July-August: Company Muster Roll: Present

September-October: Company Muster Roll: Present

November-December: Company Muster Roll: Present
