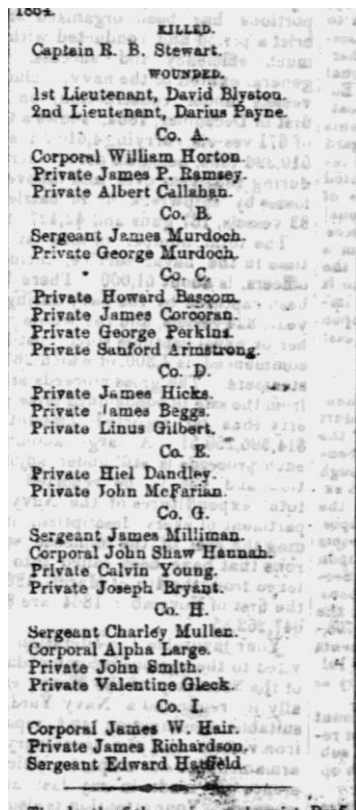


## Alpha B. Large, Corporal, Co. H 125 OH Infantry, US

- 1845 Born in Ashtabula County, OH to William and Lydia Large.
- 1850 July 15: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Ashtabula, Ashtabula County, OH Showed five-year-old Alpha living with his parents and siblings. His father, William, was a shoe maker.
- 1860 June 20: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Ashtabula County, OH listed 15-year old Alpha living with his parents and siblings. Alpha was already working as a sailor at such a young age, as were his father and two of his brothers.
- 1862 September 1: Large's brother Samuel enlisted in the U.S. Army. He was mustered into Co. A, 50<sup>th</sup> OH Infantry.
- December 1: Enlisted in the U.S. Army and mustered into Co. H, 125<sup>th</sup> OH Infantry.
- 1863 Summer: The 125<sup>th</sup> OH was garrisoned in Franklin, TN over the summer of 1863.
- 1864 March 6: Promoted to Full Corporal.
- November 30: Killed in action at the Battle of Franklin.
