1835(abt) Born in Tennessee to James and Cyntha Bassham Thaxton.

October 10: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated Jackson Tennessee showed a fifteen-year-old Meredith living with his mother and five siblings. Their occupation was not listed.

January 19: The U.S. Federal Census enumerated in Jackson Tennessee and showed a twenty-five-year-old Meredith Thaxton living with his wife, Susan, and their daughter Mary. Meredith was listed as a day laborer.

November 15: Thaxton enlisted in the C.S. Army in McMinnville TN for three years. He mustered into the 28th TN, company D.

1863 March - August: Company Muster Rolls. Present.

January - April: Company Muster Roll. Present.

November 30: Killed in action at The Battle of Franklin. He was buried in the McGavock Confederate Cemetery, section sixty-two, Tennessee grave 175.
