

August Richert, Private, Co. I, 15 TN Infantry, CS

- 1838 (abt) August Richert was born in Germany.
- 1861 June 7: Enlisted in the C.S. Army as a private and mustered into Co. I, 15th TN Infantry, CS in Memphis.
- August to October: Company Muster Rolls. Present.
- 1862 January thru December: Company Muster Rolls. Present.
- May 19: Promoted to Corporal.
- November 28: Promoted to Sergeant.
- 1863 January thru December: Company Muster Rolls. Present.
- 1864 January thru October: Company Muster Rolls. Present.
- November 30: Fought at the Battle of Franklin.
- December 15: Wounded at the Battle of Nashville,
- December 17: Captured near Franklin, TN on the Confederate retreat.
- December 23: Admitted to U.S.A. Gen'l Hosp. No. 1. Diagnosis stated as "Simple fl. Wd of Rt. thigh 1st."
- 1865 January 4: Forwarded from Nashville to Louisville and on to Camp Chase, OH where remained the rest of the war.
- May 12: Signed his oath of allegiance and was released from Camp Chase.
