December 17: Captured near Franklin, TN on the Confederate retreat.

December 23: Admitted to U.S.A. Gen'l Hosp. No. 1. Diagnosis stated as "Simple fl. Wd of Rt. thigh 1st."

1865 January 4: Forwarded from Nashville to Louisville and on to Camp Chase, OH where remained the rest of the war.

May 12: Signed his oath of allegiance and was released from Camp Chase.
