Wiley E. Barbee, Sergeant, Co. D, 13 AR Infantry, C.S.A

- 1840 Barbee was born in Tennessee to Phillip and Rhoda Barbee.
 - At some point The Barbee Family moved to Arkansas.
- 1850 October 9: The U.S. Census enumerated in Independence County, AR showed Barbee lived on his parent's farm along with his eight siblings: John, Evelina, Malisha, Joseph, Vergail, Marcus, Latitia, and Malifa.
- 1860 August 27: The U.S. Census enumerated in St. Francis County, AR showed Barbee lived on his parent's farm along with five siblings: Joseph, Marcus, Sarah, William and Frank.
- 1861 August 1: Enlisted in the C.S. Army. Company Muster Roll. Denoted Madison, AR as Barbee's point of origin.
- 1862 May December: Company Muster Rolls. Denoted Barbee as Present.
- 1863 January- December: Company Muster Rolls. Denoted Barbee as Present.
- 1864 January February: Company Muster Roll. Denotes Barbee as Present.
 - March April: Company Muster Roll. Denotes Barbee as Present.
 - July 22: Company Muster Roll. Denotes Barbee as Absent. Remarks "Wounded in Battle [of Atlanta] & sent to Hospital. Since Furloughed for 60 days."
 - November 30: Barbee was captured at the Battle of Franklin.
 - December 3: Roll of Prisoners. Barbee arrived at the Military Prison near Louisville, KY and was immediately transferred to Camp Douglas near Chicago, IL.
 - December 6: Roll of Prisoners. Barbee arrived at Camp Douglas, near Chicago IL.
- 1865 May 4: Roll of Prisoners. Barbee was transferred from Camp Douglas, to New Orleans, LA as part of a prisoner exchange.

May 11: Roll of Prisoners. Barbee arrived in New Orleans.

At some point Barbee married Frances Elizabeth "Fannie" Riddle.

- 1870 August 4: THe U.S. Census enumerated in Woodruff County, AR showed Barbee working as a farmer. He lived with his wife, their three children (Lelah T., Lulah C., and Ida E.), as well as a laborer named Burgess Strickland, and a relative of Fannie's, named Emma P. Riddle.
- November 30: According to the Arkansas Wills and Probate Records, Barbee's widow, Fannie, did receive his will and testament. It can be inferred that Barbee died some time just before this. He was about 34 years old.
